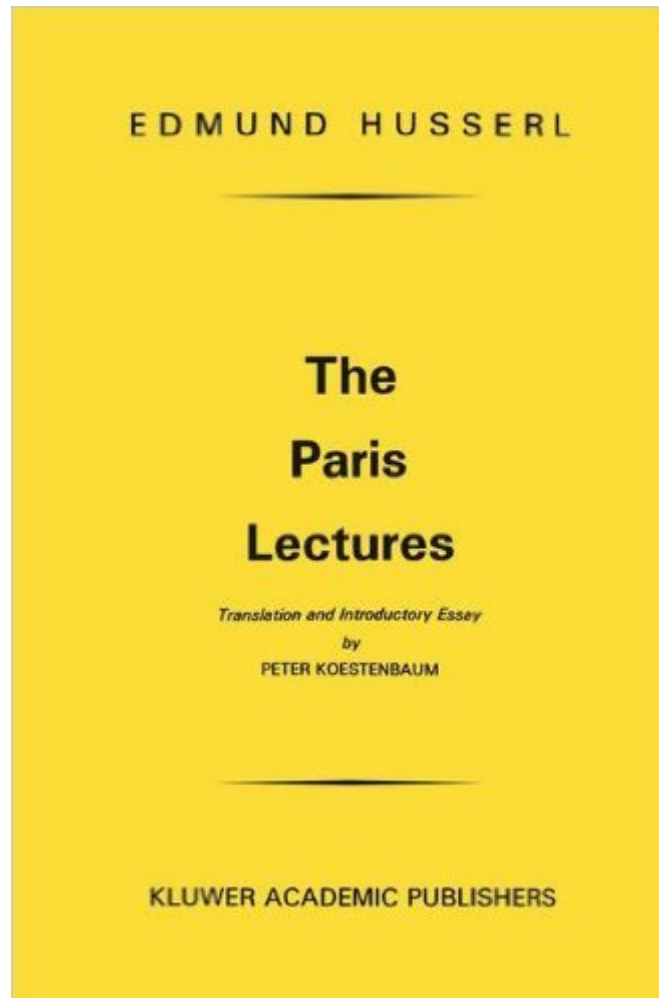


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The Paris Lectures



Synopsis

The present translation is based on the German original, which has been edited by Professor S. Strasser and published in Husserl's *Gesammelte Werke. A u j Grund des N ach lasses v e l' o j j e n t l i c h t v o m H u s s e r l' - A r c h i v* (Louvain) u n t e r L e i t u n g v o n H. L. Van Breda, vol. I (The Hague: Martinus Nijhoff, 1950), pages 3-39. Both my translation of the Paris Lectures and the Introductory Essay had been completed before the appearance of two substantial scholarly achievements: Dorion Cairns' faithful translation of Husserl's difficult *Cartesianische Meditationen* and Herbert Spiegelberg's detailed and comprehensive two-volume work, *The Phenomenological Movement*. I have since collated most carefully Professor Cairns' translation with my own in those passages which are similar in the German of the *Cartesianische Meditationen* and the *Pariser Vorlesungen*. As a result I was able to make several useful changes. Also, I have incorporated some material which had been unavailable to me prior to the publication of Professor Spiegelberg's work. However, I did not have the benefit of Dorion Cairns' *Guide to Reading Husserl*, which, at this writing, is not yet available in print. I would like to express my gratitude to the publishers as well as to Dr. Herman Leo Van Breda, Rudolf Boehm, and to the Husserl Archives for their patience, encouragement, help, and suggestions.
