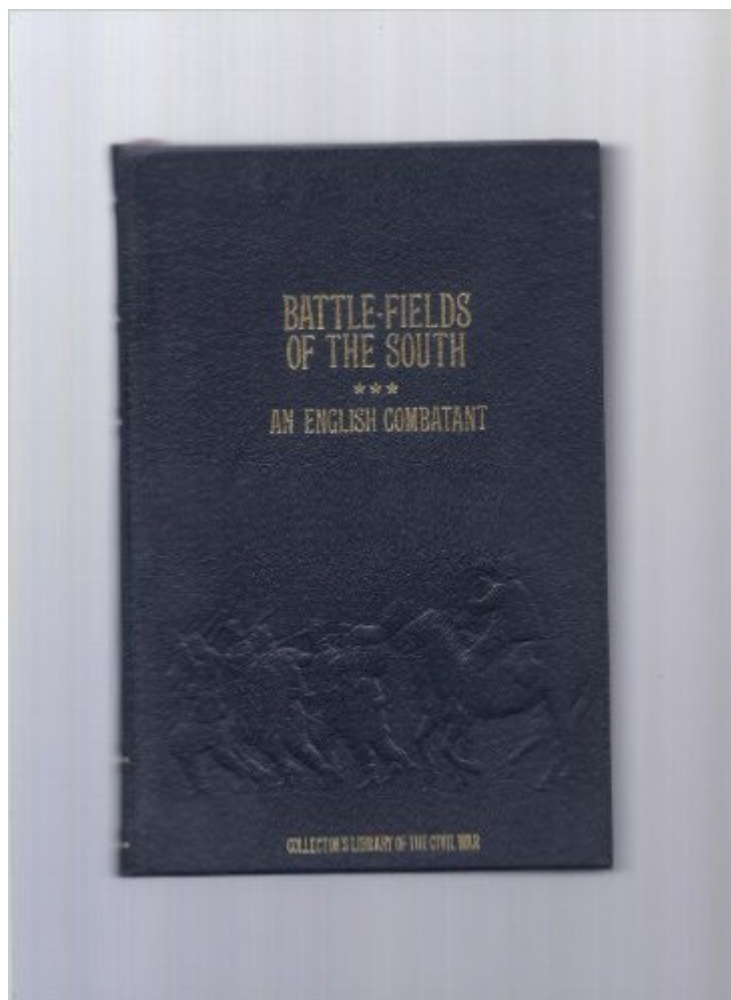


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An OK source but, seems to lack the attention that usually comes with one who has experienced all out battle.

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
